Social prescribing empowers people to take control of their health and wellbeing through referral to 'link workers' who give time, focus on 'what matters to me' and take a holistic approach to an individual's health and wellbeing. The Community Response Coordinator will work cohesively with the Link Worker, focusing on connecting people to a range of domestic and community activities across North Lincolnshire.

You will also support existing services and interventions to be accessible and sustainable and help people to start new community initiatives by working collaboratively with all local partners. The role will be focused on building strong community support systems, meaning support may be organised through extended family members, friends, neighbours, religious organisations, community programmes, cultural and ethnic organisations, or other support groups throughout North Lincolnshire.

As this is a new role, the job description may be subject to revision as the project responds to the demand of the service. The Community Response

Coordinator will be instrumental in supporting and facilitating any transformation of the service.

You will be part of a small, but committed team with big ambitions that works cohesively and effectively together to get things done. The Community Response Coordinator is an important and valued member of the team and, with the support of Citizens Advice North Lincolnshire, will be responsible for ensuring targets are met in a pressurised environment.
